

## Summer Reading 2009 Honors English 12

### Works to be read:

Books to be read are available to check out in Mrs. Patty's room:

- *Lord of the Flies* - Golding
- *Macbeth* - Shakespeare
- *King Arthur and his Knights of the Round Table* – Green

### Assignments:

Data sheets and study questions for *Arthur* are primarily for your use in reviewing before the test and essay writing. However, they will be graded. Please thoroughly complete the assignments.

#### 1. *Lord of the Flies*

- A. Quote Project – follow the directions for the quote project which follows. Read directions carefully and follow them closely. Your project should be entirely your own work.
- B. Data Sheet - You should download a sample and a template for data sheets from my web page at <http://www.teacherweb.com/AL/DecaturHighSchool/MrsJPatty/> - Click TEMPLATES on the left hand side of the page and then open Major Works DATA SHEET Template found on this page to complete the data sheet part of your assignment. Download the template into Microsoft Word and type in your information. A sample is also found on the web page. *Please note: you will have more characters than there is space for on the data sheet. List 4 or 5 central characters only under main characters. List minor characters at the bottom of the last page.*
- C. You will be tested on the novel during the first two weeks of school.
- D. You will also write an essay or answer discussion questions on the novel.

#### 2. *Macbeth*

- A. Data Sheet - *Please note: you will have more characters than there is space for on the data sheet.* Follow directions above.
- B. You will be tested on the novel during the first two weeks of school.
- C. You will also write an essay or answer discussion questions on the novel.

#### 3. *King Arthur and his Knights of the Round Table*

- A. Study questions – There are far too many characters to keep straight on a data sheet. Instead, download the study questions from the web page. Click **KING ARTHUR** on the left side of the page and download the questions to your computer. You may then type directly into the document. I strongly suggest that you answer these as you read each story.
- B. You will be tested on the novel during the first three weeks of school.
- C. You will also write an essay or answer discussion questions on the novel.
